Traveling to Hong Kong

- Airport: Hong Kong International Airport (HKG) has direct flight to many cities around the world.
- Railway: Chinese high speed train from many cities (e.g., Beijing, Shanghai, Guangzhou, Shenzhen) can go directly to Hong Kong.
- MTR: From Shenzhen Luo Wu or Fu Tian Port, you can take Mass Transit Railway (MTR)

Transportation to Symposium Venue and Hong Kong Polytechnic University (PolyU)

From Hong Kong International Airport:

Route A (1 hour)

1. From Hong Kong Airport to Tsing Yi Station: Take Airport Express Line
2. From Tsing Yi to Nam Cheong Station: Take MTR Tung Chung Line
3. From Nam Cheong to Hung Hom Station: Take MRT West Rail Line
4. Exit D1 to Hotel ICON (Symposium Venue); Exit A1 to PolyU; Exit C1/C2/C3 to Harbour Plaza Metropolises

Route B (40 minutes)

1. From Hong Kong Airport to Kowloon Station: Take Airport Express Line
2. Take taxi from Kowloon Station to Hotel ICON/PolyU/Harbour Plaza Metropolises

Route C (1.5 hour)

1. Hong Kong Airport to Hung Hom Station: CityBus A21
2. Exit D1 to Hotel ICON (Symposium Venue); Exit A1 to PolyU; Exit C1/C2/C3 to Harbour Plaza Metropolises

Route D (40 minute)

1. Take taxi from Hong Kong Airport to Hotel ICON/PolyU/Harbour Plaza Metropolises

From West Kowloon Railway Station (20 minutes):

1. From West Kowloon Railway Station to Hung Hom Station: Take MTR West Rail Line 1
2. Exit D1 to Hotel ICON (Symposium Venue); Exit A1 to PolyU; Exit C1/C2/C3 to Harbour Plaza Metropolises

From Shenzhen Airport:

1. From Shenzhen Airport to Luo Wu Station: Take Shenzhen Subway Line 1 (Luobao Line)
2. Pass the Shenzhen to Hong Kong custom
3. Luo Wu Station to Hung Hom Station: MTR East Rail Line
4. Exit D1 to Hotel ICON (Symposium Venue); Exit A1 to PolyU; Exit C1/C2/C3 to Harbour Plaza Metropolises

Local Transportation

- Taxi only accepts cash
- MTR and city bus accept cash or Octopus card (you can charge Octopus card at Seven11 Convenience stores or machines at MTR stations)
